## Technician of the Year Award

### Award Eligibility Requirements

- Be a member in good standing of the National Association of Emergency Vehicle Technicians by January 1 of the year in which the award will be presented.
- Have at least (5) years full-time employment in the maintenance of emergency vehicles.
- Be working toward or have passed any of the Emergency Vehicle Technician Certification Commission (EVTCC) Tests.
- Be working toward or have passed any of the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Test.
- Foster professionalism through participation in a local state or provincial maintenance/technician association.
- Adhere to the education of Safety Practices and procedures in his/her profession.

### Rules

Candidate must complete an official 2002 Nomination form and Questionnaire in typewritten form, and submit nomination papers postmarked by midnight May 27<sup>th</sup> 2002 for consideration by the Awards Program Committee, addressed as follows, 2002 NAEVT Awards Program Committee, P.O. Box 42308, Indianapolis, IN 46242-2308.

All winners will be notified in writing on or before June 10, 2002. Presentations will be made at NAEVT's annual Awards Banquet currently scheduled for Friday July 27, 2002 in Baltimore MD where all award recipients must be present. The winner of the 2002 Technician of the Year Award, along with his/her superior will be provided travel (to and from Baltimore), three (3) nights' lodging (in Baltimore), complimentary registration at Firehouse Expo 2002, and will be the guest of NAEVT. Certificates of Achievement will be awarded to other worthy candidates who demonstrate excellence in their profession. The decisions of the 2002 NAEVT Awards Program Committee is final.

(NOTE: Current members of the NAEVT Board of Directors and past Technician of the Year recipients are not eligible for nomination. Past recipients of a Certificate of Achievement may apply, but are eligible only for the Technician of the Year Award)
